Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI once said, "[...] You were not made for comfort, you were made for greatness."


- → Strive to center their life and ministry at Camp Carlo on Christ Jesus

- → Put in the work, striving to do the job right the first time






### **Life at Camp Carlo Will:**

• Be physically intensive - long hours, hard work, not as much rest as we might be accustomed to in our



### conduct, including:

- Good manners
- Good personal hygiene
- A dress code that is modest and functional
- No personal guests throughout the week without permission from the Director
- No personal pets
- No weapons, drugs, or tobacco



- Staff with cars must provide proof of insurance & license, keys will be kept in camp office while campers are on property
- Always without exception following all policies for keeping children safe
- Keeping peer romantic relationships from interfering with work
- No co-ed sleeping arrangements on weekends
- Be willing to go without personal electronic devices for extended periods of time
